The Challenge for Physicians

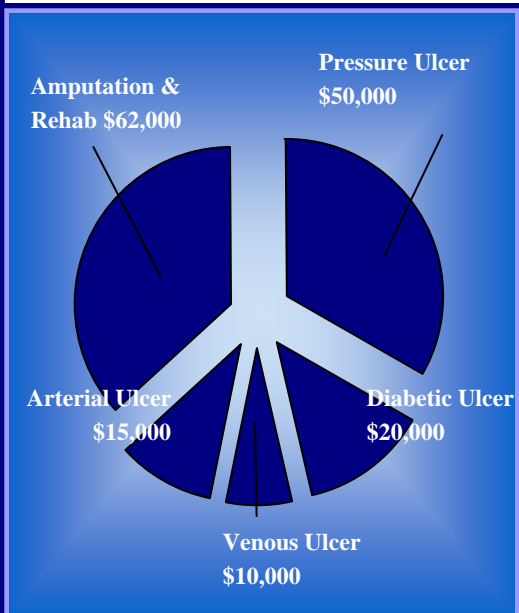
The modern healthcare environment poses many challenges for the physician who is attempting to heal a chronic wound. The etiology of wounds are as varied as the patients that present them. Below is a sample of the wounds commonly seen in the Wound Healing Center.

- Acute traumatic ischemia
- Compromised skin grafts/flaps
- Necrotizing tissue infections
- Neuropathic Ulcers
- Severe Pressure Ulcers
- Soft tissue Radiation injury
- Refractory Osteomyelitis
- Ischemic Ulcers
- Venous Ulcers
- Diabetic Ulcers
- Collagen Vascular ulcers

These ulcers typically result in delayed healing which can lead to increased frustration to the patient as well as the physician.
